WHAT: USTC Masters Challenge! USTC students will have the opportunity to challenge themselves in a safe and controlled environment. Students can participate in Traditional Forms (Individual and/or Team), Creative Forms (Individual and/or Team), Creative Board Breaking (Individual only), Power Breaking (Individual only), Jumping High Kick (Individual only), Spinning Hook Kick (Individual only), and Sparring. All students will be divided into categories based on age, weight, and ability at the USTC's discretion. In addition, all students will participate in Opening Ceremonies. The USTC Demo Team will perform and many VIPs will be present! **1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded trophies!**

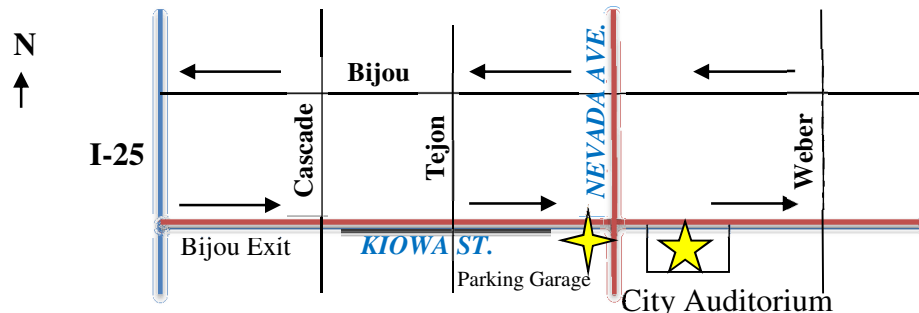

LUNCH: Concessions will be available at the venue from 11:00am – 5:00pm in the Restaurant. Multiple eating options exist downtown as well.

CHECK-IN: All check-in will be located at the Kiowa St. Main Entrance (north side). Spectator Tickets may be purchased throughout the day at the Main Entrance Ticket Booth.

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers will receive Free entry, 1 Free Meal, 1 Volunteer T-Shirt, and 1 Free Spectator wrist band (in addition to their own) for their service on the day of the event. All volunteers must volunteer for **one 2 ½ hour block**. *Time may not be broken up throughout the day.* Training will be “on the job” on the day of the event. No prior training dates will be required. **Volunteers MUST be age 15 or older.** Please sign up at the front desk of any USTC location.

HOLDING AREA: Participants should report to the holding area 30 minutes before their event begins. Rings, divisions and brackets will be organized in the holding area, before being led in groups to their appropriate ring. Parents can accompany their children to the drop-off area for escort to the holding area. Once each event is finalized, participants will be taken to the Awards area where parents can meet their children. **HOLDING AREA WILL BE LOCATED ON THE STAGE BEHIND THE CURTAIN.**

1. Individual Power Breaking Turning Back Kick
2. Individual Power Breaking Knife Hand *DOWNWARD*

NO LONGER EVENTS:

1. TEAM Jumping High Kick
2. Individual Power Breaking Knife Hand *HORIZONTAL*

EVENT RULE CHANGES

1. **Name Badges** – In the past, all participants would receive a BLUE wrist band that listed all events. Now, each participant will be issued an official name badge to wear around the neck. Participants will no longer receive wrist bands.
 - a. Spectators will STILL receive wrist bands for admission into the venue.
 - b. You will need a picture for online registration.
2. **Award Certificates** – All participants will also receive an AWARD CERTIFICATE with each trophy for each event. The award certificate will show the event name and place. (EXAMPLE: Sparring, 1st Place)
3. **Shoes-** Shoes are **NOT** allowed for any events without a Doctor’s note stating shoes are required for participation. Please bring this note with you and show it in the HOLDING AREA.
4. **Individual Spinning Hook Kick** – Age minimum was 12. Now is 8.
5. **Individual Jumping High Kick** – Age minimum was 9. Now is 8.
6. **Individual Power Breaking Knife Hand (Downward)** – Age minimum was 17. Now is 13.
 - a. There will be an official form to fill out in the holding area to specify how many boards you will attempt. Previously, it was just said “privately.”
7. **Individual Power Breaking Skipping Side Kick** – Age minimum was 17. Now is 8.
 - a. There will be an official form to fill out in the holding area to specify how many boards you will attempt. Previously, it was just said “privately.”
8. **Individual Power Breaking Turning Back Kick** – Age minimum is 8.
 - a. There will be an official form to fill out in the holding area to specify how many boards you will attempt. Previously, it was just said “privately.”
9. **Individual Creative Board Breaking** – All Boards regardless of age are 1/4 inch pine boards. Previously, Age 13 and up had to use 1 inch pine boards.
10. **Sparring** – Legal spinning kicks to the body will be awarded 2 points. Previously, all points to the body were 1 point.
 - a. All rounds are 60 seconds. In the Rocky Mountain State Games ONLY, each round will be 90 seconds. There is a 30 second break between each round.
11. **ALL EVENTS**– There are NO MORE verbal presentations BEFORE OR AFTER each event by the participant. In the past, students were supposed to say:

“Judges, my name is (student name) . I train at the USTC (Citadel, Lehman, Monument, Briargate) Dojang. With your permission I would like to break these boards, perform Tae Geuk Il Jang (or name of form).”

This has been eliminated from all events.

After Individual Creative Board Breaking students were supposed to say to the board holders:

“Line up! Charyot! Kyung Nae!”

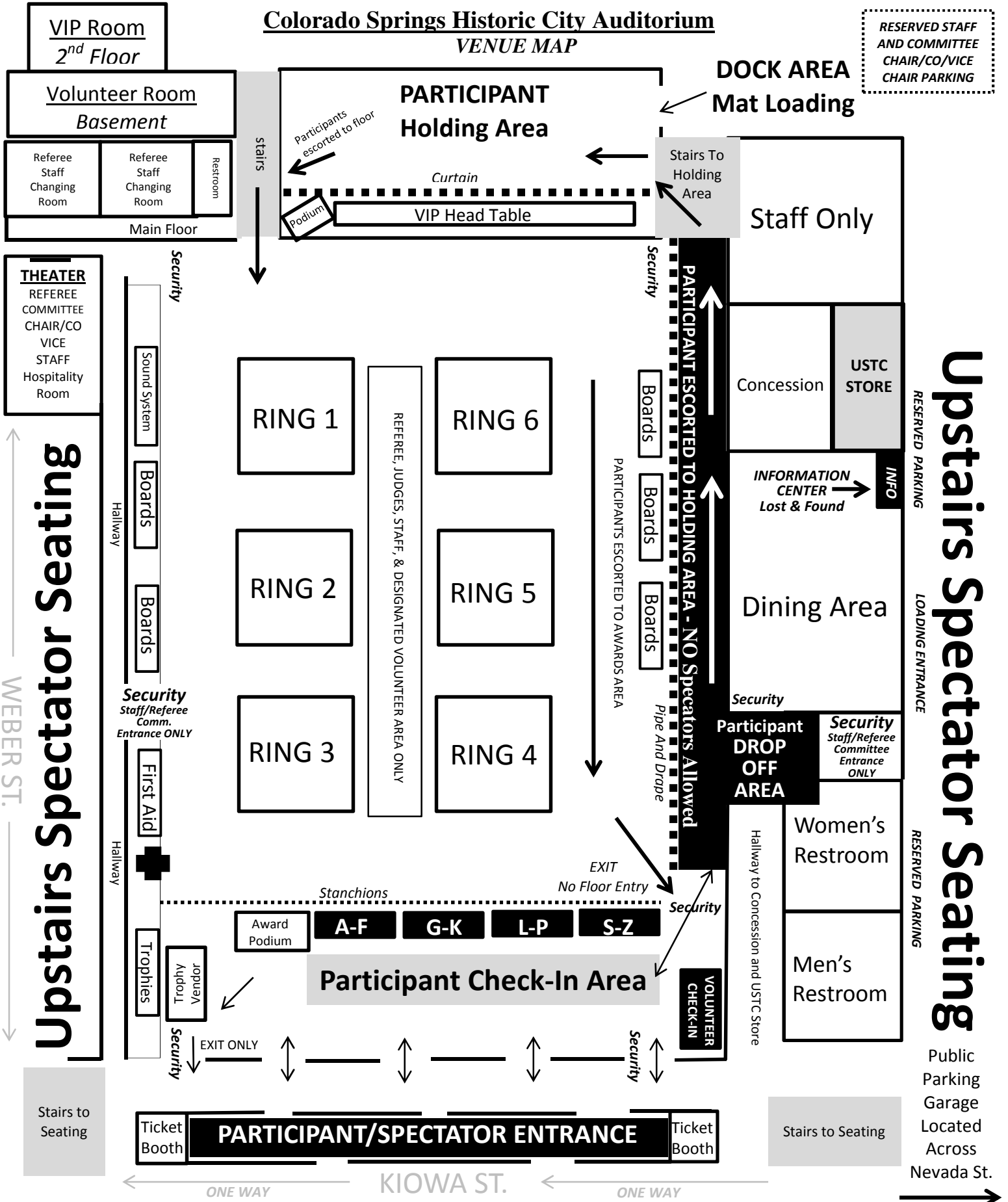
This has also been eliminated from all events.
