I am pleased to invite you to the Napa Open International Taekwondo Championship which will be held during the Labor Day weekend, September 2-3, 2017. The Championship is sanctioned by USAT and a Premier TKD League Championship and will take place at one of the very best high school venues in the country, the American Canyon High School Gymnasium at 3000 Newell Dr., American Canyon, CA 94503.

We are working diligently to provide for an exhilarating weekend to be enjoyed equally by the athletes as well as family members. The competition will feature an ALL NEW & INNOVATIVE staggered check-in system. Each age division will report to the championship at their designated times and efficiently compete in Poomsae (Forms), immediately followed by Kyukpa (Board Breaking) and then finishing off with Gyoroogi (Sparring)! We have developed this system to streamline the competition process and to eliminate the mental and physical exhaustion from long wait times. Now you can stay to support your teammates because you want to, not because you have to!

On Sunday, September 3rd, we will have three exciting and mind blowing camps and workshops for the athletes to attend. They will be instructed by internationally recognized and accomplished National Team members and World Champions, TJ Curry (Boys Camp) and Cheyenne Lewis (Girls Camp) and the Sensational Nigerian National Team member - Saturday Bashir (Trick Style Kicking Camp)! This will be a great opportunity for the athletes to grow, improve their skills and make new friends... while at the same time giving the parents an opportunity to explore and enjoy their time in the beautiful Napa Valley Wine Country!

This is the third of the five Premier Taekwondo League (PTL) Championships of the Year, where competitors earn medal points to be recognized on the "Top Ten" ranking leaderboard at www.PremierTKDLeague.com. Point values for each medal earned in Forms (Poomsae), Breaking (Kyukpa) and Sparring (Gyoroogi) are: Gold Medal = 10 points, Silver Medal = 7 points, Bronze Medal = 5 points and Participation (No Medal) = 2 points. **The PTL will host a Grand Championship and Awards Banquet in December where the Grand Champions in each respective division will be Awarded and Honored.**

We are proudly supporting our athletes by sponsoring the entry fees of \$250 for 7 Black Belt Grand Champions to compete at the WTF's President's Cup (G2,G1 World Ranking Points) in Las Vegas on October 5-8, 2017!

PTL Ranking: Medals earned will count towards the Premier Taekwondo League's "Top 10" Ranking! Gold medals are worth 10 points, Silver = 7 points, Bronze = 5 points and still receive 2 points for participation when you don't medal!

SCHOLARSHIPS: We Award all School Owners with a Scholarship Based on your School's Participation Level! 😊

COACHING: 1 Complimentary Coaching Pass for every 7 Competitors! Register online at <http://bit.ly/CoachNapaOpen> by August 25, 2017. Additional Coaching Passes are \$40.

UNIFORM & GEAR: White V-neck uniform (only white undershirt) for color belts and Black V-neck uniforms (only black undershirt) for Black Belts. No shoes, jewelry or accessories allowed. Finger & toenails must be trimmed. Sparring competitors must wear WTF approved head gear, red/blue reversible chest protector, forearm pad, shin and instep pads, groin cup (male) & mouthpiece. Open finger gloves and foot socks are optional.

RULES OF COMPETITION – ALL EVENTS ARE SINGLE ELIMINATION FORMAT – Gender/Belts/Ranks may be Combined at the Discretion of the Tournament Director

POOMSAE (FORMS): Traditional Taekwondo forms designated for their specific rank will be accepted. **WTF Poomsae (Taeguek 1-8 or Palgwe 1-8 and Black Belt Poomsae) and the ITF Poomsae (Chonji, Tan-Gun, etc.).** The winner will be chosen based on proper order, grace, rhythm, accuracy, power, breath control, stances, overall technique, martial arts manners and attitude. Compete two at a time. The judges raise and point the flag towards winner.

KYUKPA (BREAKING): Competition shall be judged based on accuracy, quality of content, # of attempts and showmanship. Compete one at a time. Winner is determined by the highest overall score. In the event of a tie, the judges raise and point the flag towards the competitor with the best spirit and manners. Must do a two station board break consisting of 1 hand technique and 1 foot technique. **Boards can be purchased online when registering or at the venue and are \$3 each or two for \$5.**

TRICKING BATTLE: This Trick Style Kicking Competition shall be judged based on gracefulness, quality of content, degree of difficulty and showmanship. Compete one at a time with music (you must supply). The judges raise and point the flag towards the winner.

GYROOGI (SPARRING): USAT & WTF Competition rules will govern this championship. **Guaranteed no same school fight in the 1st match!** 20 point gap will be used for this championship for all divisions. **All RED BELTS & ABOVE must WEIGH-IN** on Friday night (9/1/17) at the Host Hotel (Courtyard Marriott Vallejo Napa Valley) between 6pm-9pm.

AGES 7 & UNDER (ALL BELTS) AND AGES 11 & UNDER (COLOR BELTS DIVISIONS) – NO HEAD CONTACT

Sparring competitors, ages 11 & under (color belts) and 7 & under (all belts), **NO HEAD CONTACT** at any time during the competition.

SCORING

Punch to chest = 1 point
 Kick to chest = 2 points
 Turning kick to chest = 3 points

Note: Chest includes anywhere the blue/red chest protector covers.

Any competitor who executes a technique to the head area will be subject to one of the following actions:

1. Any technique attempted to the head area but does not make contact will be given a one point deduction (Gamjeom).
2. Any technique which causes injury to the head area will result in a one point deduction by the referee (Gamjeom).
3. If the competitor cannot continue because of injury caused by contact to the head area, the attacker will be disqualified.
4. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament medical staff, shall determine if there is an injury and if the attack is excessive or non-excessive.

Please Note: The inability to continue competing because of fright, crying or loss of will after a legal kick to the body, does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

AGES 8-11 (BLACK BELTS), AGES 12 & UP (COLOR BELTS), AND AGES 33 & OLDER (COLOR BELTS) – LIGHT HEAD CONTACT

1. The competitor is allowed to kick to the facial area; however, the kick must be **LIGHT HEAD CONTACT** (JSR) with appropriate control without causing any injury or excessive contact, or the appropriate penalty shall be invoked.
2. The competitor who executes a successful technique (light contact without causing injury) shall be awarded 3 points.
3. The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in a minor injury, shall receive a one-point deduction (Gamjeom). A minor injury is defined as abrasion or bleeding caused by non-excessive contact. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament medical staff, shall determine if the abrasion or bleeding is a minor injury and if the attack is a non-excessive one.
4. The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in the inability of the opponent to continue sparring because of injury shall be disqualified. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament medics, shall determine if there was excessive contact, and if the injury is a major one.

Please Note: Inability to continue competition because of fright, crying or loss of will following a legal kick to the body, does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

5. Even in the absence of visible injury, such as slight bleeding or abrasion, the referee may deem the contact to be excessive and declare the appropriate penalty.
6. Where Junior Competition Rules are in effect per USAT Article 1.B, the competitor who executes a successful technique to the face (light, controlled contact without causing any injury) shall be awarded 3 points. This is to better align with current WTF standards; however, the criteria for “excessive contact” will continue to be strictly enforced.
7. 8-Count: Under Junior Competition Rules, the referee should NOT give an 8-count for ANY technique, even a legal one, to the head area; if a kick to the head is powerful enough to warrant an 8-count it should be considered excessive, and the appropriate penalty should be declared. However, the referee can and should begin an 8-count for a legal kick to the trunk area that results in a knock-down condition.

SCORING

Punch to chest = 1 point
 Kick to chest = 2 points
 Turning kick to chest = 3 points

Kick to head = 3 point

Note: Chest includes anywhere the blue/red chest protector covers.
